Creating Connections and Community:

- DMI released the <u>2022 DMI State of the Downtown Report</u>. This year's report includes data about live, work, and play downtown. There are several new additions to the report including stories and links allowing the reader to learn more about the current state of downtown Madison.
- The State of the Downtown Report was released with a large event attracting 250 people. The
 event included a speech by Mayor Satya Rhodes-Conway and a panel discussion with Ellie
 Westman Chin from Destination Madison, Chris McIntosh from UW Athletics, Anne Morrison
 from ULI and New Year Investments, and Mark Richardson from Unfinished Business. The event
 was recorded.
- DMI hosted two New Faces, New Places events. In November, the Madison Youth Arts Center (MYARTS) hosted the event and gave a tour of the new facility. In December, US Bank hosted and welcomed the Madison Ballet for a performance during the event.

Transportation:

- At their December meeting, the DMI Transportation Committee heard a presentation from City of Madison Planner Colin Punt on the City's Transit Oriented Development (TOD) proposal. The DMI Economic Development Committee was invited to attend.
- The City is breaking ground on the new Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system in December. Completion is scheduled for early summer of 2024.

Quality of Life:

- The University Relations Sub-Committee met and discussed how to use parts of the new DMI strategic plan to guide their work. The Committee wants to work on student affordable housing issues, creating inclusive spaces and create a student focus group.
- The DMI Homelessness Sub-Committee met to discuss the new men's shelter and other homelessness related topics. The Committee is working on combining with Catholic Charities Community Advisory Committee.

Inclusiveness:

- The Inclusiveness Committee met to hear a presentation on the DMI strategic plan. The Committee also discussed their 2023 plans.
- The Beyond Compliance Task Force met to continue planning their work to assist the roll out of the 2023 Streatery program. The Task Force is also working on updating the 2018 Downtown Madison Accessibility Report.
- DMI assisted in hosting the December meeting of the Madison Area Diversity Roundtable (MADR).

Government Relations:

 The Government Relations Committee met to review and finalize the 2023 local election endorsement process.
